

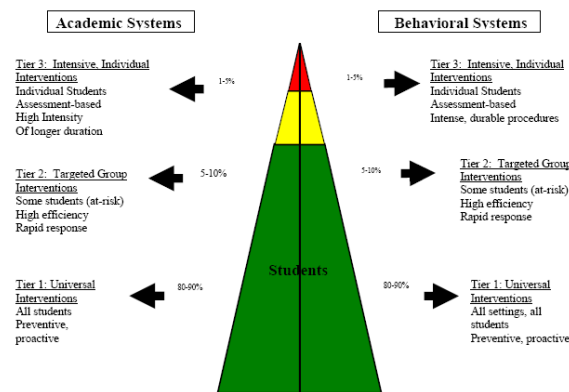
What is RTI?

RTI is a problem-solving program that is implemented to ensure every student's success.

There are multiple tiers of intervention that teachers may use when implementing an RTI plan. These tiers become gradually more intense according to the needs of the specific students, which are gauged through student-response data.
